New papers accepted for Globecom 2020

- The group at AU in Tasks 3.4 has developed a novel lightweight encryption scheme that achieves not only data compression but also asymptotic perfect secrecy for resource-constrained IoT devices. The work will be reported in the paper "Energy Concealment based Compressive Sensing Encryption for Perfect Secrecy for IoT" at the IEEE Globecom conference in December 2020.
- The group at AU in Tasks 3.4 has also designed a multi-class privacy-preserving cloud computing scheme that provides multi-class encryption and allows computationally expensive sparse signal recovery to be performed at cloud without compromising the confidentiality of data to the cloud service providers. The work will be reported in the paper "Compressive Sensing based Multi-class Privacy-preserving Cloud Computing" at the IEEE Globecom conference in December 2020.
